

6. Expected results

6.1 Expected impact on target groups

At the end of the project, young and promising staff members at CLM-NAU and EEU-UoE have been trained in The Netherlands and Germany in recent theories in the field of resource and environmental economics and have become familiar with modern teaching methods and advanced research methodologies and data analysis methods. These skills are an essential prerequisite for adapting education in the field of resource and environmental economics to the requirements of the emerging market economy (economic liberalisation, changing resource management institutions) in China and Vietnam. Moreover, it is expected to enhance the international orientation of education and research at both institutes, and raise their levels up to international standards.

6.3 Multiplier effects

The bilingual teaching course at CLM-NAU (activity A1.) will be attended by teaching staff in related fields at other universities in China. The project will therefore affect teaching at these universities as well. After their graduation, most students at CLM-NAU are employed by the central government, provincial governments, universities and research institutes, and private organisations. The restructuring of education in resource and environmental economics at CLM-NAU will therefore have important effects on future policy making in this field and on research and education by other institutes in China (see 1.6).

Similar indirect effects on future policy making, research and education are expected to arise from the project activities targeted at the EEU-UoE in Vietnam. In addition, attendance of teaching staff from other universities in Vietnam at the teaching activities at EEU-UoE (activities A2. And A3.) will be strongly encouraged.
